Taking place over 10 days, participants will divide their time between exploring the tropical rainforest and learning about Belizean marine life.

At a Glance:

- Dates: May 29 June 6, 2017.
- Hike in the rainforest at Hill Bank Field Station and learn about sustainable forestry efforts.
- Snorkel in the Belize Barrier Reef, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Visit the Mayan ruins at the Lamanai Archaeological site.

Estimated Costs:

- Approximately \$3,100 before scholarship award.
- \$1,700 after scholarship award.
- Cost includes: Airfare, airport taxes, ground transportation, accommodations, travel medical insurance, all meals.
- Cost does NOT include: Tuition and fees (3 credit hours), passport application (if needed).

Eligibility:

- Have earned at least 6 college-level credits prior to the anticipated travel date.
- Must be at least 18 years old at the time of travel.
- Have a 2.0 GPA at the application deadline date.
- Additional awards maybe available for qualified students.

Scholarships to cover partial expenses will be awarded to qualified students on a first come, first served base.

Award Recipient Eligibilities:

- Apply by the deadline date to receive the full scholarship amount.
- Be a degree-seeking student at HCC (dual enrollment and transient students do not qualify for an award).
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at the time of application.
- In order to retain your scholarship after enrolling, **you must meet all course and attendance requirements**, obtain a grade of C or better and complete a scholarship project in collaboration with the CIE office.
