PLA 2933 Legal Studies Seminar: Law, Culture, & Conflict Resolution

NEW study abroad opportunity for Summer 2018! In this course, students will explore the areas of Constitutional Law, Conflict Resolution, and Civil Rights in Ireland and Northern Ireland. Significant focus will be placed on exploring the connections, influences, and tensions between the law and the cultures of those countries.

Estimated Costs:

\$2,825 before scholarship award

\$2,025 after scholarship award

- Cost includes: Airfare, airport taxes, ground transportation, accommodations, travel medical insurance, tours/entrance fees, and all breakfasts plus four dinners.
- Cost does NOT include: Tuition and fees (3 credit hours), passport application (if needed), lunches, and eight dinners.

Eligibility:

- Have earned at least 6 college-level credits prior to the anticipated travel date.
- Must be at least 18 years old at the time of travel.
- Have a 2.0 GPA at the application deadline date.



Take this opportunity to travel the world with no commitments but to study and learn about different culture. Studying abroad is an experience unlike any other.

Award Recipient Eligibilities:

- Apply by the deadline date to receive the full scholarship amount.
- Be a degree-seeking student at HCC (dual enrollment and transient students do not qualify for an award).
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at the time of application.
- In order to retain your scholarship after enrolling, **you must meet all course and attendance requirements**, obtain a grade of C or better and complete a scholarship project in collaboration with the CIE office.
