# IDS 2891 Connections: Global Citizenship

This is an exciting opportunity for Summer 2016! This IDS course offers the opportunity to become immersed in the Peruvian culture through a volunteer program that offers the chance to serve, learn, experience, and enjoy. You will learn about history, including the history of the Inca people. You will discover a culture in all its colors, smells, tastes, and traditions. In your free time, you might choose to experience the sand dunes of Huacachina or explore, if time permits, Machu Pichu. But most of all, you will come to know Peru as a local, as one who has lived and learned there.

## Eligibility:

- Have earned at least 6 college-level credits prior to the anticipated travel date.
- Preference will be given to students who have completed at least 45 credit hours of coursework toward their degree.\*
- Must be at least 18 years old at the time of travel.
- Have a 2.0 GPA at the application deadline date.

\*Students who completed IDS 2891 OR do not meet the 45 credit hours requirement are welcome to audit the course.

## Estimated Costs:

Approximately \$2,600 before scholarship award,

## \$1,500 after scholarship award.

- Cost includes: Airfare, airport taxes, ground transportation, accommodations, travel medical insurance, all meals.
- Cost does NOT include: Tuition and fees (1 credit), passport application (if needed).
- Selected participants are guaranteed a scholarship. Additional awards are also available for qualified students.

## Award Recipient Eligibilities:

- Apply by the deadline date to receive the full scholarship amount.
- Be a degree-seeking student at HCC (dual enrollment and transient students do not qualify for an award).
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at the time of application.
- In order to retain your scholarship after enrolling, you must meet all course and attendance requirements, obtain a grade of C or better and complete a scholarship project in collaboration with the CIE office.
