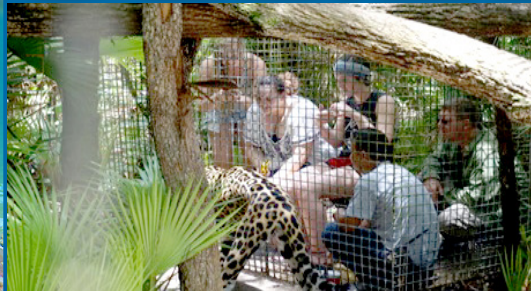

IDS 2159 Biological, Tropical & Environmental Sciences

This is an exciting opportunity for Summer 2020! Be swept away by beautiful tropical scenery while learning about Belize's diverse ecosystem and earning elective credit for IDS 2159 Environmental Issues. Taking place over 9 days, participants will divide their time between exploring the tropical rainforest and learning about Belizean marine life.

At a Glance:

Dates: **June 1-9, 2020**

- Hike in the rainforest at Hill Bank Field Station and learn about sustainable forestry efforts

- Snorkel in the Belize Barrier Reef, a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Visit the Mayan ruins at the Lamanai Archaeological site

Estimated Costs:

- **\$1,500 after scholarship award**
Appx. \$2,800 before scholarship award
- Cost includes: Airfare, airport taxes, ground transportation, accommodations, travel medical insurance, all meals.
- Cost does NOT include: Tuition and fees (3 credit hours), passport application (if needed).

Eligibility:

- Have earned at least 6 college-level credits prior to the anticipated travel date.
- Must be at least 18 years old at the time of travel.
- Have a 2.0 GPA at the application deadline date.

Scholarships to cover partial expenses will be awarded to qualified students on a first come, first served base.

Award Recipient Eligibilities:

- Apply by the deadline date to receive the full scholarship amount.
- Be a degree-seeking student at HCC (dual enrollment and transient students do not qualify for an award).
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at the time of application.
- In order to retain your scholarship after enrolling, **you must meet all course and attendance requirements**, obtain a grade of C or better and complete a scholarship project in collaboration with the CIE office.
