Estimated Costs:

Approximately \$3,100 before scholarship award

- Cost includes: Airfare, airport taxes, ground transportation, accommodations, travel medical insurance, all meals.
- Cost does NOT include: Tuition and fees (3 credit hours), passport application (if needed).

Scholarships to cover partial expenses will be awarded to qualified students on a competitive base.

Eligibility:

- Have earned at least 6 college-level credits prior to the anticipated travel date.
- Must be at least 18 years old at the time of travel
- Have a 2.0 GPA at the application deadline date.
- Favorable in-person interview

Award Recipient Eligibilities:

- Apply by the deadline date to receive the full scholarship amount.
- · Be a degree-seeking student at HCC (dual enrollment and transient students do not qualify for an award).
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at the time of application.
- In order to retain your scholarship after enrolling, **you must meet all course and attendance requirements**, obtain a grade of C or better and complete a scholarship project in collaboration with the CIE office.
