Learn about alternative energy in Denmark—a world leader in the field! Participants will spend 15 days touring sustainable energy sites, factories and green houses across the country. Another highlight of the program are homestays with host families, giving students the opportunity to experience authentic Danish culture and build lasting friendships. Students from HCC will be joined by a cohort from Singapore resulting in a truly multi-cultural experience. The trip concludes with a day to explore Denmark’s capital, Copenhagen.

- Travel dates: **June 2 - 17, 2017**
- Visit sustainable energy facilities.
- Take a tour of a sustainable village.
- Learn about the latest research at the Danish Technological Institute.

Estimated Costs:

- **Approximately \$3,500 before scholarship award.**
- **\$2,100 after scholarship award.**
- Cost includes: Airfare, airport taxes, ground transportation, accommodations, travel medical insurance, all meals.
- Cost does NOT include: Tuition and fees (3 credit hours), passport application (if needed).

Financial Aid:

You may use Financial Aid to pay the cost after receiving scholarship award.

Eligibility:

- Have earned at least 6 college-level credits prior to the anticipated travel date.
- Must be at least 18 years old at the time of travel.
- Have a 2.0 GPA at the application deadline date.

Scholarship Award Recipient Eligibilities:

- Apply by the deadline date to receive the full scholarship amount.
- Be a degree-seeking student at HCC (dual enrollment and transient students do not qualify for an award).
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at the time of application.
- In order to retain your scholarship after enrolling, **you must meet all course and attendance requirements**, obtain a grade of C or better and complete a scholarship project in collaboration with the CIE office.
