

IHS 2110C — Introduction to Global Health: Study of Selected Country NUR 2650C Transcultural Nursing: Study of Healthcare in an International Setting

This study abroad course introduces students to global health issues with emphasis on a selected country. The course will examine various issues which influence health outcomes and compare health care delivery systems. Students will analyze personal professional development as they examine various health care disciplines.

- Week 1 in Quito and Week 2 in Rainforest/Venecia
- Immerse yourself in Andean culture and health practices

- Hybrid course (3 credits)
- 1 lecture credit: 15 clock hours (9 hours pre- and post-international experience and 6 hours in-country)
- 2 clinical credits: 75 clock hours (in-country experience)
- Service learning: 10 hours

Estimated Costs:

- Approximately \$2,500 before scholarship award
- \$1,500 after scholarship award
- · Cost includes: Airfare, airport taxes, ground transportation, accommodations, travel medical insurance, all meals.
- Cost does NOT include: Tuition and fees (3 credit hours), immunizations, passport application (if needed).

Eligibility:

- Have earned at least 6 college-level credits prior to the anticipated travel date.
- Must be at least 18 years old at the time of
- Have a 2.0 GPA at the application deadline date.

Scholarship Recipient Eligibilities:

- Apply by the deadline date to receive the full scholarship amount.
- Scholarships to cover partial expenses will be awarded to qualified students on a competitive base.
- Be a degree-seeking student at HCC (dual enrollment and transient students do not qualify for an award).
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at the time of application.
- In order to retain your scholarship after enrolling, you must meet all course and attendance requirements, obtain a grade of C or better and complete a scholarship project in collaboration with the CIE office.
